- * In the 1920s, the York Cone Company was established in York, PA.
- * By 1972, the York Company was taken over by Peter Paul.
- * In 1978, Peter Paul merged with Cadbury Schweppes.
- * 10 years later in 1988, Hershey Foods bought Cadbury Schweppes' U.S. confectionery operations.
- * The newest product of YORK is the YORK Pieces candy, which was introduced by HERSHEY'S in 2009.
